**Secretary's Report:** The minutes from the last meeting was sent out to the club members prior to this meeting. Mike Moore made a motion to approve the meeting minutes: none opposed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Chris Jaques provided the treasurer's report: The club currently has:

### **Committee Reports:**

**Engineering/Technical Committee:** Mike Moore reports that there is nothing to report at this time.

#### **Public Relations and Recruitment Committee:**

Delbert Long discussed what could be included in the new ham kits.. Betty Rush called Don Jarvinen for his input as Don has brought ARRL handouts to the club's testing site. An ARRL article was brought to the club regarding what East Greenbush Amateur Radio Association created in their new ham kits. Their club found it to be a valuable tool for new hams.. Don Darcy recommended to get handouts from manufacturers

Ryan suggested that the kit include an ARRL band plan poster and a list of local repeaters.

**Activities Committee:** Terry Fuller provided an update on the events.

- 1. **24 Apr UHF/VHF QSO Party.** Terry Fuller thought this event was very successful. Terry Fuller reports that he had 17 call signs and he sent the results.
- 2. **25-26 June is Field Day.** This event will overlap the **BH100** race.
- 3. **10 July: Tailgate/Auction party** will be held at Robbinsdale Park and will start around 8:00am for setup. Gary Peterson will be the auctioneer with the auction starting at approximately 10:00 or 10:30. The club is planning on publishing a partial list of equipment for sale as well as equipment from Chuck Palmer's estate sale. There will be: ICOM 706s, VHF only Kenwoods. J-poles, mobile mag mounts. The estate sale is a fundraiser for the club.
- 4. **SOTA BBQ: 16 Jul:** The club is planning a club barbeque on Friday evening at Canyon Lake Park for a barbeque. We are looking for someone to cook for this event. More details to come.
- 5. **17-18 Jul, Summits on the Air:** Terry Fuller invited people from out of the area and there may be three groups from out of state. There will be more details to come.

#### **Old Business:**

1. Chris Jaques provided an update on the last VE testing: 6 examinations were given and they were all passed with two techs getting their first ticket, one general from nothing

- prior, two upgrades from tech to general, and one upgrade from general to extra. Chris Jaques states that there will be a new testing session in July.
- 2. John Murphy inquired who are the new members. There has been a big influx of hams signing into the groups.io.
- 3. Ryan Lindblom states that it would be good to introduce new hams to equipment and methods.

#### **New Business:**

- 1. Mike Moore asks the club regarding the status of Triband 10-15-20m band antenna parts. Andy Pattantyus states that the parts are ordered, but MFJ sent a note that the order is delayed. Andy Pattantyus will follow up on Monday.
- 2. Radar Hill Clubhouse Building Repairs

Ryan Lindblom states that we need more repairs to the clubhouse. Terry Fuller did measurements and estimates. The club needs to weatherproof and seal the building. Terry Fuller shows pictures that he took while he was out at the clubhouse. Soffit at one of the corners, and by the tower. Fascia is 1x8 and all needs to be replaced. Both entryways need new soffit and fascia, and need tin roofs, and a 1:12 pitch. Terry Fuller also took photos looking into the ceiling. Roof screws are 3" pole barn screws. 1500 screws need to be checked to see if they are "soft" and need to be reset. Somebody plugged the vents. Need to remove, and check if the screens are intact. The storm doors will need to be replaced.

Lumber is now \$3 a foot for pine.

Terry Fuller priced soffit with pine and aluminum. \$2500 material and 160 hours of labor. The club will eed to schedule work days. Terry asked for a hand count, who could devote 6 hrs a day for 2 Saturdays. The club is looking for club members with construction experience. 15 people responded. Terry Fuller is planning on scheduling this.

Ryan LIndblom calls for the club to make a motion for the club to approve this expenditure to fix the clubhouse. Mike Schaff made a motion for the club to approve this expenditure; none opposed. Terry Fuller also reports that the \$2500 is a high-end estimate and is looking at hardy siding for the fascia.

3. John Murphy wants to donate 8 strips of cement board, in red color, to help with the construction of fixing up the clubhouse. John Murphy will also donate any extra and he has the special saw blade for cutting.

**Adjourn:** John Murphy made a motion to adjourn the meeting; none opposed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:48 pm.
